- ◆ Negative TB Test Results (good for four years)
- ◆ Signed Volunteer Clearance (see below)

All volunteers are asked to sign-in at the school office and wear a school volunteer badge during each volunteer session.

VOLUNTEER DOCUMENT REQUIREMENTS

_____ I understand that I must have a current negative TB Test Result Form (completed by physician or clinic) on file in the school office. Should there be a change in my health, I will inform the office and cease volunteering. *(Please initial)*

_____ I understand that I must either be fully vaccinated against Covid-19 OR participate in home antigen testing. If not fully vaccinated, I affirm that I will conduct weekly home antigen tests for COVID-19 and obtain a negative result prior to entering school buildings or facilities. Regardless of vaccine status, I will not attend any school activities if I am experiencing illness. *(Please initial)*

VOLUNTEER CLEARANCE *EDUCATION CODE SECTION 35021*
